



Suicide prevention training and resources for people from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds

The Queensland Mental Health Commission engaged Health Outcomes International (HOI) to undertake a review of suicide prevention training and resources (e.g. information, publications) to support people from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds.

As part of this process, we are undertaking a series of consultations including focus groups and telephone consultations with key stakeholders including community representatives in Queensland.
